AVT Grom Fender Eliminator Install Guide

1) Remove the rear seat with your motorcycle key.

2) #1: Unplug the electrical black plugs coming out of the OEM fender. Remove any wire tie downs holding the wires going to the OEM fender to the bike. #2: Remove the 4 bolts holding the OEM fender to the bike and lower it out of the way. #3: Replace the LED relay. #4: Unplug the clear tail light plug and remove any tie downs holding the wire.



3) Install your new AVT fender eliminator: Feed the wires form your new fender eliminator into the OEM location and attach the fender eliminator bracket with (2) OEM bolts and nuts provided.

4) #1: Unscrew the (2) screws holding the tail light fairing. Remove it by gently prying up on the two sides to release it. #2: unscrew the (2) tail light nuts. Remove the OEM tail light.



5) Install the new integrated tail light into the OEM location and reinstall the tail light fairing.

6) Connect the electric connectors: 1: Clear plug from the tail light into the OEM clear plug on the bike. 2: Plug in the pin of the yellow tail light wire with black mark under the black wire in the fender eliminator plug. Plug in yellow pin under the red wire in the fender eliminator plug. 3: Black plug from the fender eliminator into the black plug on the bike.



7) Reinstall the rest of the components in reverse order:

1: the seat
2: license plate



Ensure that all of the OEM and new lights function properly before your first ride! ANY electronics can fail. That's why every motorcycle safety course will teach that it's the riders responsibility to check all the safety equipment of the bike before getting on every time you ride(including break light and turn signals). They also teach you that for the most part car drivers do not "see" a motorcycle at all! Most drivers are unfortunately just not looking for motorcycles; turn signal/break light on or not. It's our responsibility to make sure to ride defensively and assume that no one sees us!
